# Air Pollution Catcher

## STEP 1

Cut out a piece of card or cardboard.



## STEP 2

Create a small hole near one edge. Loop a string through the hole and tie a knot in it.



## STEP 3

Add a generous amount of Vaseline (petroleum jelly) to one side of the card.



## STEP 4

Attach the card to a pole or fence in your garden.



## STEP 5

Leave it outside for 24 hours.



## STEP 6

Take the card down. You will be able to see all the particle pollution stuck to the Vaseline. If you want, you can leave it outside for longer.

How does it look after 2 days? 3 days? A week? Discuss your findings with your friends who have also done the same experiment.
